Answer the following questions in your assignment:

1. What are the ***traditional*** instruments (do not include drums, electric guitar or bass) that are used in each performance? In your opinion, how does the use of these instruments help further the message or "philosophy" of heavy metal music? Answer in no more than 2 paragraphs.
2. Find an example of each traditional instrument that you identified during our museum visit. ***Include a picture of each instrument in your assignment.*** Briefly explain, in 2-3 sentences, one interesting fact that you learned about an instrument from the museum exhibit. It is possible that some instruments may not be on display (if that is the case, note that in your assignment).
3. Explore the other museum exhibits. Include a picture of a piece of art that is "the most metal" in your opinion. In 2-3 sentences, explain why it exhibits a "metal aesthetic."
4. Watch the documentary film, Global Metal. In your opinion, what is it about metal that appeals to people across vastly different cultures? Provide one example from the film to explain your answer. Answer in no more than 1 paragraph.
